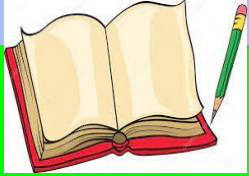

The Catholic Virtues - Rewards



Prudence (Wisdom) When we demonstrate *prudence*, we receive rewards for excellent **classwork, homework**, and when we show that we are really making **progress** in our **learning** by showing clear **knowledge** and **understanding** of the topic we are working on.



Fortitude (Courage) When we demonstrate *fortitude*, we receive rewards for being brave by **answering questions, volunteering, having a go** when we find the work difficult, **persevering** and **showing** that we are willing to overcome any difficulties in our learning by **not giving up**.



Temperance (Self-control) When we demonstrate *temperance*, we receive rewards for being able to **control our behaviour by not being silly**, making **appropriate contribution** to class discussion, **speaking to all adults and each other with respect**, **listening and concentrating**, and **playing by the rules**.



Justice (Fairness) When we demonstrate *justice* we receive rewards for **being fair**, **owning up when we make a mistake**, taking on **roles of responsibility** to make **positive changes** to our school and the world in which we live, and for **standing up for what is right**.
